**Check**

**( A ) DO ALL OF THE FOLLOWING:**

Earn the BSA National Centennial Quality Unit Award (completed by Recharter Day on 12/11/2011).

Earn the National Summertime Pack Award for 2010.

*Service to Others*

Participate in at least **one** “Good Turn” i.e. Scouting for Food, Lake Allatoona Cleanup, Adopt-a-Mile, Adopt-a-Spot, Adopt-a-Road, Adopt-a-Highway; Adopt-A-Cemetery; (or similar program)

**( B ) DO TWO OF THE FOLLOWING:**

*Community Participation/Awareness:*

ScoutFest @ Cobb Galleria (10/23/2010)

Kennesaw’s Big Shanty parade (04/10) or Acworth Love the Lake parade (9/10)

Mountain Lake area cemeteries’ Memorial Day Flag Project (05/10)

Create a “Scout Week” promotion (display in a local store window, shopping center, etc.)

Scout Sabbath/Sunday service (02/10)

Held a Chartered Organization “awareness event” promoting our pack to our Chartered Organization.

**( C ) DO ALL OF THE FOLLOWING:**

*Adult Training/Participation:*

All our registered active adults have received Youth Protection Training in 2009 or 2010.

75% of our adult leaders that were registered prior to 2010 have completed Fast Start on line training and Classroom Position Specific training. **New leaders** who have registered with our pack **during 2010** have completed at least Fast Start Training for their position as a minimum.

A minimum of one leader has attended District or Council BALOO training.

**( D ) DO ALL OF THE FOLLOWING:**

*District / Council Activities*

Have at least one member at 10 of the District's 12 Roundtables.

Participate in District Day Camp and/or Council Webelos Encampment and/or Council Resident Camp for Wolf/Bear and/or Webelos Woods and/or Cub Turkey Shoot/Cuboree

**( E ) DO ONE OF THE FOLLOWING:**

One adult member (or more!) serve on one of the District's Operating Committees or Commissioner Staff.

Provide at least one adult staff member at a district or council event (e.g.- Webelos Woods, Cub Day Camp, WAP, District Advancement Days, Training, Turkey Shoot, Scout Fest, Council Activity Days, Wood Badge, Scouter's Academy, etc.).

**( F ) DO THE FOLLOWING:**

**Advancement**

Achieve the advancement goals that you set for your youth members in each den.

**Finance/Support of the Program**

Sponsor a Friends of Scouting campaign in your unit and turn in report to District Executive

Participate in BSA 2010 Popcorn Sales

**Membership**

Participate in School Night for Scouting, or a Chartered Organization Sponsored recruitment effort. i.e. LDS Church's units registration

Complete Recharter by December 11, 2010 Recharter Day.

Hold a uniform inspection and membership inventory conducted by our Unit Commissioner
