Participate in at least **one** “Good Turn” i.e. Scouting for Food, Lake Allatoona Cleanup, Adopt-a-Mile, Adopt-a-Spot, Adopt-a-Road, Adopt-a-Highway; Adopt-A-Cemetery; (or similar program)

(B) DO TWO OF THE FOLLOWING:

Community Participation/Awareness:

Acworth’s Love the Lake Parade (9/10) or Kennesaw’s Big Shanty parade (04/10)

ScoutFest @ Cobb Galleria (Oct 23, 2010)

Mountain Lake area cemeteries’ Memorial Day Flag Project (05/10)

Created a “Scout Week” promotion (display in a storefront window, shopping center, etc.)

Scout Sabbath/Sunday service (02/10)

Hold a Chartered Organization “awareness event” promoting our pack to our Chartered Organization.

One adult member (or more!) from our unit serve on one of the District's Operating Committees or Commissioner Staff

Provide at least one adult staff member at two district/council events (e.g.- Camporees, Merit Badge Clinics, ScoutFest, Training, Scouter's Academy, Wood Badge, Campout of the Century, College of Commissioner Science, etc.).

Submit a current merit badge counselor list to the District Advancement Committee (not required for Venturing Crews)

Finance/Support of the Program

Sponsor a Friends of Scouting campaign in your unit and turn in report to District Executive

Membership

Conduct an event (not just a meeting) for Webelos or a recruiting event for new scouts, or a Crew Open House for recruiting new members. Participation at District Webelos Open House qualifies.

Hold a uniform inspection and membership inventory conducted by our Unit Commissioner.

Complete Unit Recharter by December 11, 2010 Recharter Day.
