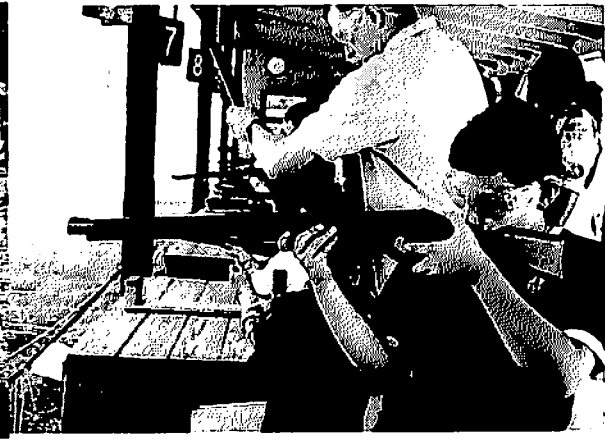

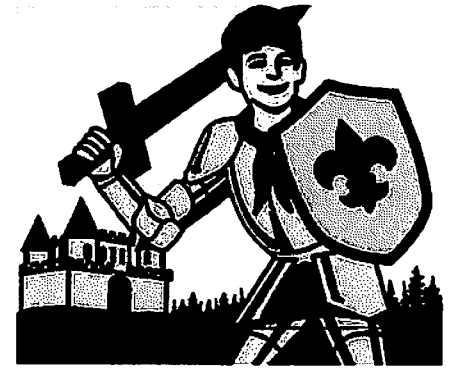

"Adventures of the Round Table" Cub & Webelos Adventure Camps

Grab your suit of armor and come join us for "Adventures of the Round Table" at Bert Adams Scout Reservation! This coming summer, Bert Adams will host Adventure Camp for Cub Scouts, Webelos Scouts, leaders, and families. While packs are encouraged to come as a group, many parents and boys choose to attend camp as a family. Either method is good as long as your son attends adventure camp. Siblings, age 6 and up may participate in all camp activities.



Adventure Camp offers a unique age-specific, grade appropriate, exciting program for all Cub Scouts, Webelos Scouts, and their families who attend. Campers have the opportunity to participate in a variety of programs including sports, handicrafts, nature, swimming, boating, and a whole lot more. **Cub Scouts** can swim, spend a day on the lake, go hiking, learn

handicrafts, and much more. **Webelos Scouts** will be able to work on Webelos Activity Badges and belt loops, cook, swim, canoe, learn handicrafts, and participate in shooting. Webelos may also experience our special Outback Adventure.

Adventure Camp Facilities

You'll sleep in a comfortable tent featuring four mattress frames with pads. Extra sleeping pads for additional campers can be checked out from the staff, if needed. Tents sit on wooden platforms and you can close them at night for privacy. Modern bathroom facilities include private hot showers and flush toilets. Webelos Scouts, rising fourth and fifth graders, are encouraged to bring their own tent as part of the program. Tents can be provided if necessary. Meals will be prepared and served in the dining hall.

Weather

Bert Adams Scout Reservation is located in the Appalachian Piedmont. Weather can change quickly and campers must be prepared. Afternoon rain showers are common but do not stop the program. Bring plenty of clothes and shoes so you can stay dry. Be Prepared!!!

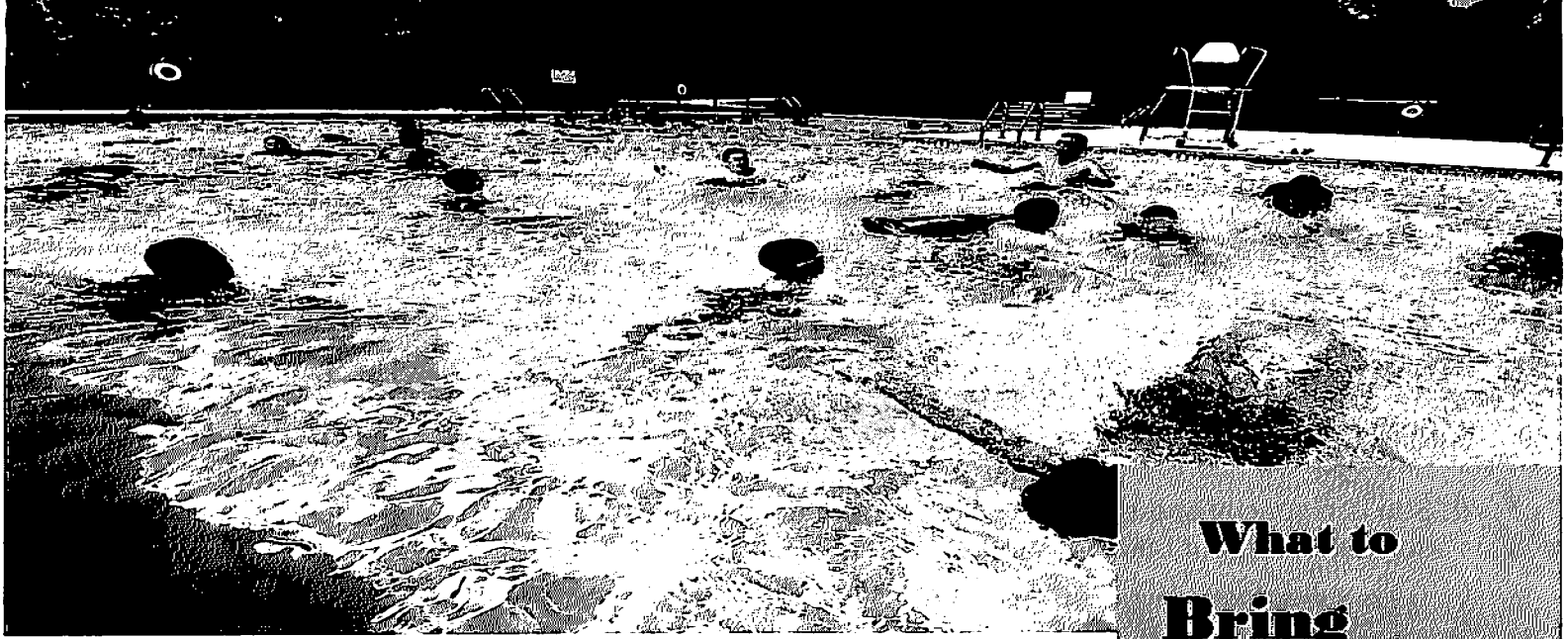
Adult Leadership

Minimum adult leadership by the family and unit is required as follows:

- All Cub Scouts must be accompanied by a parent or guardian in a 1:1 ratio.
- Webelos Scouts must attend with the following adult leadership:

1 Webelos Scout : 1 Parent
2-4 Webelos Scouts : 2 Leaders
5-8 Webelos Scouts : 3 Leaders
9-12 Webelos Scouts : 4 Leaders

Camperships

Scholarship money is also available for Scouts who qualify. Request a form from your local district executive or the program center. Forms are due for review by May 1.

Scouts are also encouraged to use credit they have earned from the Camp Card sale toward a trip to Adventure Camp.

Arrival and Departure Times

Check in starts at 1pm; your first meal is dinner. You will depart after breakfast on the last day.

COST

All fees include program and meals. \$35 deposit per person is required at the time of reservation. Balance of fees is due 12 days prior to camp.

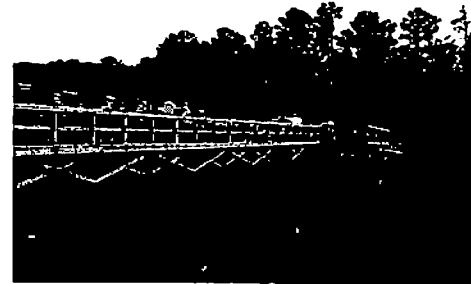
Fun with Son Weekend
